Below are my comments in response to the e-mail from Gordon Cooper (TCEQ) to you dated ____ regarding the Lubbock County SWMP. These responses apply to all the EPA-defined "urbanized areas" based on the 2000 Census.

Item #1, MCM1: Public Education and Outreach

Comment: Please provide additional information as to how visitors and construction site personnel will know about or to check the website for storm water information.

Response: As described in BMP 1.1 (PSAs and Press Releases), Lubbock County will pursue an inter-local agreement with the City of Lubbock to co-author PSAs and press releases. It is through the production and distribution of information that visitors and construction site personnel will be informed.

Item #2, MCM 3: Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

Comment: Please provide additional information about how the SWMP addresses appropriate actions and enforcement procedures for removing the source of an illicit discharge, to the extent allowed by state and local law.

Response: BMP 3.4 of the Lubbock County SWMP provides for the inspection of identified or suspected sources of illicit connection. The BMP 3.5 provides for the continuation of enforcement of existing ordinances. Lubbock County will review its existing ordinances to ensure that illicit discharges are removed to the extent allowed by state and local law.

Item#3, MCM 4: Construction Site Storm Water Runoff Control

Comment: Please provide information that will confirm that Lubbock County will be addressing the required elements for construction activities at sites 1 acre and larger including construction activities at sites that are part of a larger common plan of development.

Response: Lubbock County will review its existing ordinances to ensure that it incorporates the appropriate storm water runoff erosion measures to address the reduction of stormwater discharges from construction activity disturbing greater than to equal to 1 acre, including projects less than 1 acre that is part of a larger common plan of development. If the existing ordinances are found to be lacking, Lubbock County will pass resolutions to address the shortcomings.

Item#4, MCM 4: Construction Site Storm Water Runoff Control

Comment: Please provide information as to how sanctions/enforcement will be carried out by the county, for qualifying construction activities, to the extent allowed by state and local law.

Response: Lubbock County will review its existing ordinances to ensure that sanctions/ enforcement activities are provided, defined and carried out for qualifying activities. If the existing ordinances are found to be lacking, Lubbock County will pass resolutions addressing the shortcomings.

Item#5, MCM 4: Construction Site Storm Water Runoff Control

Comment: Please provide additional information about how the SWMP addresses (1) procedures for site plan review to consider water quality impacts, in this MCM (4), and (2) procedures for the receipt and consideration of input from the public in relation to storm water runoff from construction activity.

Response: (1) Lubbock County will pursue inter-local agreements with the City of Lubbock and the City of Wolfforth to address the review of plans within the extra-territorial jurisdictions (ETJs) with respect to considering water quality impacts. Site plan reviews are required for sites within the cities' ETJs. The City of Lubbock's ETJ extends 5 miles from the city limits, while the City of Wolfforth's ETJ extends ½ mile beyond its city limits. The "urbanized areas" of Lubbock County are totally within the cities' ETJs. Lubbock County will develop and implement County Standard Erosion and Sediment Control Plan. (2) The county will accept input from the public in relation to storm water runoff from construction activity. Contact information will be provided in PSAs and press releases.

Item #6, MCM 5: Post-Construction Storm Water Management for New Development and Redevelopment

Comment: Please provide information that will confirm that Lubbock County will be addressing the required elements for new/re-development activities at sites of 1 acre and larger including new/re-development activities at sites that are part of a larger common plan of development.

Response: Lubbock County will develop and implement County Standard Erosion and Sediment Control Plan addressing the required elements for new/re-development activities at sites of 1 acre and larger including those sites that a part of a common plan of development of 1 acre and larger.

Item #7, MCM 6: Pollution Prevention / Good Housekeeping Measures for Municipal Operations
Comment: Please provide additional information that will identify any industrial activities owned by the county that require TPDES permits. (i.e. – TXR050000-MSGP permit)

Response: Lubbock County does not have any industrial activities that require TPDES permit located within the urbanized areas as defined by EPA based on the 2000 Census.
