

The Texas Public Information Act (TPIA), also known as the Open Records Act, allows the public access to government information. As a governmental entity, Lubbock County places a high priority on openness in government. For persons wishing to make a request for information under the TPIA, the request must be in writing. The request must ask for documents or information already in existence. The request may be sent by regular mail or special delivery, hand-delivered, faxed, or emailed.
